**Subject:** Supplemental Update to Compliance Complaint – Improper Attendance Coding for Kaleb Xiong

Dear CDE Investigator,

We are submitting this supplemental update to our December 2025 Compliance Complaint against Elk Grove Unified School District regarding our son, **Kaleb Xiong**.

Since December 3, 2025, EGUSD has continued to mark Kaleb's absences as *unexcused*, despite the fact that Kaleb is unable to attend school **solely due to district-created safety concerns and the district's failure to implement essential IEP-required supports**, as documented throughout our complaint.

These safety issues—along with the district's continued refusal to provide services or assessments in an accessible alternative setting—have made it unsafe and impossible for Kaleb to return to school. The district's actions directly prevent his attendance. Under these circumstances, it is inappropriate and misleading for the district to record the absences as "unexcused."

We have notified the school principal and district administrators and have formally requested that:

- 1. All absences beginning December 3, 2025 be corrected; and**
- 2. Any ongoing absences that occur while the district's unresolved safety and implementation issues remain outstanding be marked as excused absences.**

Because the absences are the direct result of the district's noncompliance and failure to provide a safe and accessible educational environment, we request that CDE incorporate this ongoing attendance concern into the scope of the investigation.

This continued misclassification harms Kaleb and creates the appearance of parental noncooperation, when in fact the district's own failures have made attendance impossible. We respectfully ask that CDE review this issue as part of its determination regarding EGUSD's compliance with IDEA and California law.

Please let us know if you require any documentation or correspondence related to our attendance correction request.
