Your recent letter of December 9, 2025, was received by the Special Education Division's Dispute Resolution Units on December 9, 2025. Your correspondence has been carefully reviewed, and the following information is provided for your assistance.

As a result of your request for state intervention, a complaint investigation, case S-0824-25/26, has been initiated, and the notification explaining the investigation process has been mailed separately. The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you that some of your concerns are not able to be investigated at this time, because:

- The issue(s) exceed the one-year statutory limit for opening complaints.
- The issue(s) do not express a violation of special education laws or regulations but rather cite to laws or codes which are outside our scope, which is federal and state special education law, which may include issues regarding future events or personnel matters.
- The issue(s) are currently being investigated or have previously been investigated in a compliance complaint dealing with the same student, allegation, public agency, and timeframe.
- While you have identified special education law, your request does not include facts to establish a potential alleged violation.
